Re: General Education

Dear Chancellor Tan:

I would like to submit for your consideration and endorsement through the President to the Board of Regents, for their approval, the following resolutions by the UP Diliman University Council at its 142<sup>nd</sup> (special) meeting held on 20 March 2017.

A. Motion that the current GE program of UP Diliman be changed

With votes of 302 in favor, 31 against, and 44 abstentions, the motion to change the current UP Diliman GE program was adopted by the UC.

B. Proposals 1, 2, and 3 concerning GE curriculum structure

Proposal 1: 21 units core, 6-24 units elective/program-prescribed = 27-45 units of GE

Proposal 2: 21 units core, 0-24 units elective/program-prescribed = 21-45 units of GE

Proposal 3: 21 units core, 15-24 units elective/program-prescribed = 36-45 units of GE

With 37 votes in favor of Proposal 1, 139 in favor of Proposal 2, 17 in favor of Proposal 3, and 1 abstention, Proposal 2 was adopted by the UC.

Proposal 2 is shown in detail in Annex A, including courses according to domains.

Chronology of the review and revision process is summarized in Annex B following.
