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Further to Memorandum No. OVCAA-BMP 17-288 dated 24 March 2017, it was reported to the Executive Committee at the meeting on 8 May that 16 Departments and Institutes (among 38 with current or proposed GE offerings) had replied to PART A, announcing their intended GE course offerings in AY 2018-2019 with the following categories: Existing GE courses without revision; Existing GE courses with revision (to be proposed); and New GE courses (to be proposed for approval by the relevant committees, the University Council and the Board of Regents.)
