We have been allowed a couple more days to complete our delegation of General Education faculty members who will attend the UP System Conference on 4-6 July 2017 (venue TBA). Hence, for each System-wide GE course, one or more Diliman departments or institutes are anticipated to be ready to host and/or offer.

We are sending this follow up memo through all the Deans and Heads of Academic Units, welcoming all institutes and departments who may send faculty delegates. INVITATION TO THE UP SYSTEM GE FACULTY CONFERENCE 2017

As you are aware, the General Education Program of our University has undergone several revisions since its institution in 1958, the latest of which is the 2010 revision of the Revitalized GE Program (RGEP) that established the so-called Hybrid GE. Three years later (in 2013), external factors—i.e., the major change in the country's formal education system with the addition of Senior High School, the implementation of ASEAN Frameworks with profound impact on higher education; the complex global issues and challenges that include: climate change and natural disasters; new diseases and threats to health and public safety; economic exploitation and extreme poverty; social conflicts, wars, international terrorism (and of late, "fake news", "alternative facts"); and the exponential growth of knowledge and emergence of new technologies—impelled the UP Administration to introduce the proposed *Revision of the GE Program*.

While the GE Framework and objectives have not changed substantively, the paradigm shift from education to lifelong learning has also called for a serious rethinking of the way GE courses are taught and whether our teaching meets the GE objectives, e.g. for instance, whether our students are able to reflect critically on shared concerns and think of innovative, creative solutions guided by "the loftiest principles at the core of a UP education".

Since 2013, the UP System has conducted several system-wide conferences/workshops and miniconferences involving disciplinal experts and other GE faculty representing the different CUs. Eleven (11) GE courses were proposed in the conferences/workshops. Course outlines were subsequently finalized and presented by representatives from the mini-conferences to the System GE Council. In the past two years, these course outlines have also been discussed in CU fora and workshops.

To consolidate comments from these CU workshops, further refine the outlines prior to approval of your respective units and the BOR; and plan the next steps, our **UP System Conference**, as mentioned in the GE Council and AAC meetings will be held during the midyear break, specifically on **4-6 July 2017**.

For this Conference, we urge you to send 3 to 4 the experts for each of the following GE courses:

- 1. Critical Perspectives in Communication (COMM 10)
- 2. Critical Perspectives in the Arts (ARTS 1)
- 3. Ethics and Moral Reasoning for Everyday Life (ETHICS 1)
- 4. Kasaysayan ng Pilipinas (KAS 1)
- 5. Living Systems: Concepts and Dynamics (SCIENCE 11)
- 6. Mathematics, Culture and Society (MATH 10)
- 7. Philippine Arts and Culture (PHILARTS 1)
- 8. Probing the Physical World (SCIENCE 10)
- 9. Science, Technology and Society (STS 1)
- 10. Self and Society (SS 1)
- 11. Wika, Kultura at Lipunan (WIKA 1)

The Course Outlines are attached for your reference. In addition, included is a table template that you can use.

Please submit, in consultation with the heads of the units, the names of the experts you will send to the Conference on or before 15 June 2017. Your submission will facilitate accommodation arrangements at the conference venue.
