NUMBER OF PARTICIPANT SLOTS PER COLLEGE/UNIT

Note: In the past UPD GE Conferences, the number of participant slots allocated for each college/unit was determined using the formula Number of Participant Slots = 2 x Number of GE Courses that the College Unit Offers. Colleges/units that do not offer GE courses are given one (1) slot each.

For the 2015 Conference, the allocation has been modified a bit. Specifically, the minimum number of slots per college/unit has been set at:

- One (1) for colleges/units that do not have an undergraduate degree program AND do not offer GE courses; and
- Four (4) for colleges/units that have an undergraduate degree program but do not offer a GE course OR offer only one (1) GE course.

This year's GE Conference will have several simultaneous workshops. To allow all colleges/units with undergraduate programs to participate in all of the workshops, the minimum number of participants has been increased.

For the rest of the colleges/units, the usual number of slots was retained.
