The conference is an occasion for us to collectively reflect on the new global and national context for GE, including challenges confronting liberal education, and articulate new directions and imperatives for GE in the 21st century.

We invite the GE faculty to submit papers for presentation on any of the following sub-themes:

**A. Global Perspectives on General Education**

- GE and geopolitical crises (Russia-Ukraine war)
- GE, climate change (forest fires, flooding), and environmental crises
- GE and the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals)
- GE and the Fourth Industrial Revolution / Industry 4.0
- GE and Artificial Intelligence and the future of work
- UP GE vis-a-vis Liberal Education in Asia and beyond
- GE and the infodemic, disinformation/misinformation, and social media
- *Other related topics*

**B. UP General Education and the Filipino Nation**

- Historical revisionism; GE and Philippine history
- GE as/and Tatak UP
- GE and Constitutional freedoms/democratic rights
- GE and gender-based violence and the Internet (e.g., online sexual exploitation of women and children)
- GE, language, and culture
